**5.2.5 IEEE 2016 Membership Cycle** Participated in nationwide IEEE 2016 Membership Development (MD) Kickoff webinar. The July report is attached. The 2015 membership cycle closes next week. R6 performed relatively well in meeting its goals yet still lost

members. Of the 35 Sections five surpassed their recruitment goal and two have surpassed their retention goal for 2015. R6 as a whole has surpassed its reinstatement goal.

OCS 2015 performance was good, but not enough. Recommendation is that 2016 OCS focus be on new member recruitment, member grade elevation and member retention

- 5.3 Treasurer's report. July ending balance \$84,078.52. August 15 balance \$84,097.80. There were no July disbursements.
- **5.4 R6 Education Activities Report** Brian reported on the R6 San Francisco OpCom planning and budgeting meeting. Initiatives are deployed in the southern region than propagated throughout the entire region. A joint R4 and R6 NSF grant application has been submitted which is intended to fund a Scholar Initiative for students and professors and an IEEE Toolbox Initiative for HW and SW tools. Brian explained the Intel Computer Clubhouse deployed to help underserved populations, funded by the Intel Foundation, and which supplies, equipment and staff in combination with a local non-profit organization.
