## SPRING 2025 FRANCIS RHODES MONTGOMERY DESIGN COMPETITION RESULTS

#### SPRING 2025 FRANCIS RHODES MONTGOMERY DESIGN COMPETITION

The Francis Rhodes Montgomery Design Competition (FRMDC) is proudly hosted by the ASME Hawaii Section and aimed to the students of Mechanical Engineering with the goal of recognizing and rewarding their senior capstone design. ASME has been hosting it for 38 years since its inception in 1987. This event is co-sponsored by the University of Hawai'i, Department of Mechanical Engineering (DME) and the ASME Hawai'i Francis R. Montgomery Foundation. The DME Spring 2025 FRMDC was held on Friday, May 9, 2025 at the University of Hawai'i at Manoa, Hawaii Institute of Geophysics Building Room 110.

The competition consisted of 8 teams from the ME 481/482 design course. The teams presented their projects and described their objectives, design challenges, engineering principles that were applied, project results, expenditures, and gave credit to their sponsors. Upon conclusion of the presentations, a poster session & hardware demonstration was followed in which the teams were able to provide additional information about their projects to the judges.

The students were able to present a variety of projects that are described afterwards in which it showcased their ingenuity and demonstrated work that can have a direct impact in Hawai'i. They cared about reducing waste and supporting individuals in recovery from medical events, as well as, designing and manufacturing satellites, drones, a rocket and an EV formula car, showing improved processes by using the latest currently available technologies that made their presentations very interesting.

Following the ASME/FRMDC scoring rubric, the judges ranked the teams as follows with First place and \$500 awarded to Team PFR (Plastic Filament Recycler), in second place and receiving \$300 was Team Hokulele, and in third place and \$200 was Team AFWD Team.

#### FIRST PLACE: TEAM PFR - PLASTIC FILAMENT RECYCLER

The goal of this project is to develop a 3-in-1 Polylactic Acid (PLA) recycling system to reduce Fused Deposition Modeling (FDM) 3D printing waste at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa (UHM). The system integrates a Shredder, a Dryer, and an Extruder to convert failed prints and support structures into recycled filament spools. This project addresses the growing environmental concerns associated with additive manufacturing by providing an efficient, closed-loop recycling system.

#### SECOND PLACE: TEAM HOKULELE – TWO-STAGE HIGH-POWERED ROCKET

Team Hōkūlele is developing a two-stage high-powered rocket with a target altitude of 25,000 feet in accordance with the Friends of Amateur Rocketry (FAR) FAR-Unlimited Competition requirements. The purpose of this project is to inspire future University of Hawai'i at Mānoa students to collaborate, compete


in an international aerospace engineering competition, and represent Hawai'i within the rocketry community.

#### THIRD PLACE: TEAM AFWD - AIAA FIXED-WING DRONE TEAM

The AIAA Fixed-Wing Drone Team has designed, analyzed, constructed, and tested a radio-controlled (RC) fixed-wing aircraft system in preparation for a mock 2025 American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics (AIAA) Design/Build/Fly (DBF) Competition. The DBF Competition challenges student teams internationally to apply aerospace engineering principles through the hands-on development of aircraft capable of completing mission-specific tasks under real-world constraints.

#### **TEAM LEWA LANI - CANSAT**

The name Lewa Lani, meaning "Highest Stratum of the Heavens" in Hawaiian, symbolizes the team's aspirations for excellence. Team Lewa Lani is a senior capstone design team from the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa, developing a CanSat–a small, fully functional satellite payload designed to perform tasks such as data collection, telemetry transmission, and controlled descent after being deployed from a rocket.



#### TEAM WALX – WEARABLE AMBULATORY LIFTING EXOSKELETON

The Wearable Ambulatory Lifting eXoskeleton (WALX) is a cost-effective, lightweight mobility aid designed to support individuals in recovery from medical events—such as strokes or surgeries. WALX addresses the limitations of current exoskeleton systems, which are often expensive, complex, and physically demanding for the hospital staff to operate or assist patients with. With a prototype cost of approximately \$6,000, WALX presents a promising step towards more accessible and user-friendly exoskeletal devices.

#### TEAM BALLOONSAT - ADVANCED BALLOON SATELLITE 9

The University of Hawai'i Advanced Balloon Satellite 9 (UHABS-9) is the ninth balloon satellite (BalloonSat) iteration within the program's history. Hawai'i poses a unique challenge in recovering BalloonSat equipment, given that each island is surrounded by ocean. To resolve this dilemma, the UHABS-9 team shall develop an ocean recovery vehicle for a high-altitude BalloonSat capable of autonomously delivering its data-recording payload to a predetermined recovery site after a water landing up to 1 mile off the coast of O'ahu.

#### TEAM UHDT – UNIVERSITY OF HAWAI'I DRONE TECHNOLOGIES


Developing a new UAV (Unmanned Automated Vehicle) that is capable of autonomous waypoint navigation, autonomous object detection, and autonomous payload delivery. In addition, the new airframe will be more portable (with foldable arms), capable of operating in rain (with waterproof electronics/ avionics), and includes a parachute recovery mechanism in case of an emergency. These improvements will reduce the time UHDT spends transporting the drone to and from the airfield and ensure flight tests do not need to be stopped or canceled due to adverse weather conditions.


