

CLEAN ENERGY WAYFINDERS: EMPOWERING HAWAII'S COMMUNITIES

Energy powers our modern lives but navigating the complexities of Hawaii's energy ecosystem can be a daunting task. That is a problem the Clean Energy Wayfinders are here to address.

The Clean Energy Wayfinders program is designed to reflect Hawaii's rich cultural and historical tradition of wayfinding in which trained navigators helped lead their communities to new places where they could sustain a better quality of life. The Hawaii State Energy Office (HSEO), working in partnership with the energy industry and community stakeholders, developed the Clean Energy Wayfinders program in response to community concerns about energy projects' benefits and impacts on host communities that have made it clear that a more intentional effort must be made to reach out to include everyone in Hawaii to more effectively, efficiently, and equitably achieve our 100% clean energy and carbon-free economy goals.

The Wayfinders share information and opportunities for energy conservation and clean energy adoption with Hawaii's schools, community organizations, and households. They help increase energy conservation and efficiencies, lower monthly energy utility bills, increase access to clean transportation and renewable energy resources, and promote green career training and employment opportunities. Wayfinders focus their support in low- to moderate-income (LMI), asset-limited, income-constrained, employed (ALICE), and under-resourced communities to level the playing field and uplift often unheard voices.

With recruiting focused within the targeted communities, the Wayfinders receive energy and community outreach and engagement training to provide their communities with access to federal Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) and Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) funds, statewide Solarize initiatives, community-based renewable energy (CBRE) subscriptions, and clean energy workforce development opportunities.

In the process, Wayfinders help establish channels of communication and build trust between communities, HSEO, county energy offices, and energy industry stakeholders. Wayfinders help community members access green job opportunities and provide additional means for community voices to be heard by policymakers and project developers to more effectively collaborate and guide

decision-making. Wayfinders also participate in networking opportunities with program and industry partners to pursue future opportunities and build their pathways for living-wage green careers in Hawaii.

HSEO is starting its second year of the Clean Energy Wayfinders program. Six Wayfinders will be serving the islands of Kauai, Oahu, Molokai, Maui, and Hawaii Island to continue building community capacity and participation in Hawaii's renewable energy transition. Five of the six Wayfinders are returning for a second term. The Wayfinders that left us have stayed in Hawaii and moved into clean energy and community outreach positions with other organizations – which was an intended outcome of the program! Two current projects currently underway are educating communities about the emerging fields of decarbonization and coastal resilience. More exciting news will be out very soon.


Decarbonization: Decarbonization is an economy-wide effort to reduce greenhouse gases emitted into the atmosphere while increasing the capacity of natural and technological carbon sinks. HSEO is developing a statewide Decarbonization Strategy which will describe potential scenarios and actions for Hawaii to reach net-negative emissions by 2045. The Wayfinders will support HSEO's outreach and engagement efforts for the Decarbonization Strategy by developing accessible materials and engagement opportunities covering foundational information that everyone should know to best participate in Decarbonization discussions. Addressing Decarbonization can be intimidating because it is an economy-wide conversation that requires a level of technical understanding of topics including climate change, greenhouse gases, the carbon cycle, and the many sectors that contribute to our state's emissions, so the Wayfinders will focus on "translating" the information to best meet community members where they are while drawing connections to existing community priorities. They will also broaden HSEO's engagement capacity by bringing the Decarbonization conversation to schools, community events, and meetings.

Understanding Energy Transitions and Coastal Resilience: HSEO is partnering with UH Sea Grant on a project funded by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) focused on building sustained dialogue and relationships between island communities across Hawaii to inform

renewable energy futures. This two-year project will expand HSEO's Energize Kākou program by working closely with community organizations to co-develop outreach and engagement strategies based on community needs and culture, build community capacity for understanding and participating in energy transition conversations, and identify community priorities for increased climate and energy resilience. The project will also include a conference bringing together other grant awardees from Alaska, Puerto Rico, and Guam to share progress and opportunities for further collaboration between coastal communities.

The Wayfinders continue to seek avenues to connect with community organizations, schools, and other groups and invite those interested to reach out to local Wayfinders to explore ways to collaborate and collectively envision Hawaii's sustainable energy future!


SAME National Vice President, Mr. Michael Huffstetler attended in person and shared an update on the 2025 SAME Strategic Plan.
