Report on IEEE Section Congress 2020 Recommendations Event By Alberto Tam Yong 8 October 2020



The IEEE Section Congress 2020 was initially scheduled for August 2020 but then cancelled due to the pandemic crisis. The organizing committee was able to at least move forward with a virtual Recommendations Event to ensure the feedback of the IEEE members around the world was collected. The event was set as two sessions. Session 1 was hosted on September 1st, and Session 2 was hosted on September 15th. The sessions included a few Guest Speakers, including executives from IEEE. In Session 1, there was a great presentation on "How to be Successful in a Virtual Environment" with a great review of IEEE resources available to volunteers. Session 2 included presentations from the Industry Relations Committee and the VoLT (Volunteer Leadership Training) program and projects.

The main goal of the event was to complete the selection of the Top 3 Recommendations that would shape the strategic planning and priorities of IEEE for the next 3 years.

The Top 3 Recommendations that received the most votes are:

- 1. Create a 3-5 multi-year IEEE membership fee structure with discounts
- 2. Provide continuing education to provide true value added for working professionals
- 3. Provide resources to Sections to serve industry professionals and engage with local industries



Top Three 2020 Recommendations

RECOMMENDATION 4

Create a 3-5 multi-year IEEE membership fee structure with discounts



This structure would benefit IEEE by ensuring that the members stay with IEEE for a longer period. The structure would also greatly benefit members by providing options for more cost-effective membership. Other professional societies have been exercising multi-year membership fee structures which have proven to be highly effective and successful.

Top Three 2020 Recommendations



RECOMMENDATION 10

Provide continuing education to provide true value added for working professionals



Present short courses on emerging technical topics including a documented certification, including professional development hours. To increase member retention, offer 3 courses per year to each member. Additionally develop online presentations similar to TED talks on engineering topics.

Provide resources to Sections to serve industry professionals and engage with local industries



To better serve industry professionals, IEEE to provide industry seminars including technical presentations, opportunity to earn professional development hours and networking opportunities. IEEE also to provide structural resources such as a Customer Relationship Management platform to track local industry contacts and training to engage with local industries.
